


Living History Curriculum Activity Day

History is one of the areas where the National Curriculum leaves plenty of scope for thinking outside of the box. It's difficult for children to grasp just how different life was in ancient times, but our Living History Days not only cover Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 learning outcomes, they bring the past to life and make learning effective, memorable and fun.

We'll help your group learn ancient skills such as lighting fires, building shelters and making arrows. By putting these activities into the context of Neolithic, Bronze, or Iron-Age societies, they'll get a vibrant sense of how things changed and developed over time.

There's plenty of opportunity to find out about change, continuity, cause, similarities, and differences, which all go towards building up a sense of history and a love for the subject.
